QUALIFICATION & EMPLOYMENT RELATED

Healthcare

Maternity Care Support, 5N3746 QQI Level 5 Minor Award - 10 wks. Fee €200

Tuition will focus on the care of mother and baby, supporting midwifery teams, knowledge of infection control and maintenance of a clean and safe environment in the maternity unit.

For assessment purposes, the student will be required to demonstrate competence in practical skills in a number of procedures normally carried out in a maternity unit. In addition, two written assignments are required.



Anatomy and Physiology 5N0749 QQI Level 5 Minor Award- 10 wks. Fee €220

This course will enable the student to develop a knowledge and understanding of the functions and structure of the human body. The course is suitable for students who need a science subject to enable them to apply for nursing. It is also suitable for those working in the healthcare sector, community care and beauty therapy to gain a greater understanding of the structure and functions of the body.



Assessment is by means of a written theory based exam and two assignments.

Creative Arts

Painting, 5N1302 QQI Level 5 - 20 wks. Fee €420

This course offers students the opportunity to learn the technical and creative aspects of painting. The assessment of learning will consist of preparing a portfolio for the QQI Level 5 Minor Award in Painting. This will require students to show their competence in a range of artistic skills as well as showing progression in terms of research and understanding of their creative ability.

Tourism

National Tour Guiding, 6S20232 QQI Special Purpose Level 6 Award - 26 wks.

Fee €950

As tourism is such a fast growing industry in Ireland and the number of overseas visitors to our shores is set to increase significantly over the next few years, the demand for qualified tour guides has never been higher. This course is aimed at people who have a genuine interest in their locality, have a very positive appreciation of Ireland's history, culture, tradition and folklore and who are enthusiastic about sharing this with others. On successful completion of this course participants will receive the National Tour Guiding (white) Badge and may be included in the approved Tour Guide Directory that is hosted on the Fáilte Ireland website.

Business and Technology

Digital Marketing QQI Level 5 & Project Management QQI Level 6 - 26 wks.

Fee €570



This course will teach and assess a broad range of both Digital Marketing & Project-Management skills. The modules delivered on this course are as follows:

5N1364 Digital Marketing

6N4090 Project Management

The course aims to provide students with the skills, knowledge and aptitude to manage and scale projects using digital marketing and social media tools.

HOBBY & SELF-IMPROVEMENT

Creative Arts

Pottery (Beginners/ Improvers) - 10 wks. Fee €220

This course teaches the basic methods/ techniques of pottery for making 3D forms, including pinching, slabbing, coiling and throwing. Students will also get an opportunity to learn the following:

- Preparing clay for ceramic craftwork
- Roll and join clay to form slab pots
- Form and join coils to make coil pots
- Relief sculpture
- Decorate finished craftwork using glazes
- Introduction to throwing clay on the potter's wheel
- Creative 3D hand building
- Mold making

Pottery (Advanced) - 22 wks. Fee €340

This course offers students the opportunity to develop their skills in ceramic making techniques. Students are encouraged to work outside of existing comfort zones. Students will be encouraged to experiment with clay as a sculptural medium by joining made components playfully together; considering form and function, texture and decoration.

Creative Arts

Painting for Absolute Beginners - 8 wks. Fee €110

This eight week painting course is designed for absolute beginners. Teaching will include demonstration in the following:

- Painting media
- Brushwork
- Composition
- Colour - mixing



Louise Morgan 'Lemon', 2019

Painting for Improvers - 5 wks. Fee €110

This is a short refresher course in painting. It is designed to bridge the skills from beginners to improvers and is suited to students intending to progress to the Painting QQI Level 5, 5N1302 minor award.

Textile Art for Beginners - 3 day workshop Fee €230

This 3-day course is suitable for individuals who have no experience of making textiles but have always wanted to try it out. It is a practical course, which, teaches the basic techniques and helps you to understand some of the key elements of design.

Creative Arts

Glass Slumping/ Fusing (Beginners/ Improvers) - 10 wks. Fee €250

Suited to absolute beginners as well as those with some experience of working with Glass.

Tuition will consist of the following:

- Cutting and shaping glass using various tools
- Understand the firing process
- Experiment with a range of glass materials
- Learn slumping and fusing techniques

Analogue Photographic Techniques - 10 wks. Fee €320

This course covers analogue photography and darkroom techniques. You will learn how to take photographs with an analogue camera. Students are asked to bring their own analogue camera.

Tuition will cover the following:

- Camera Controls
- Processing black & white 35mm film
- Photographic styles, e.g., Portraiture, Street Photography and Landscape Photography
- Exposure triangle
- Principles of lighting and composition
- Darkroom printing

Creative Arts

Creative Writing for Absolute Beginners - 8 wks. Fee €100

Lots of people have a desire to write yet have not begun the journey nor have they persevered because they lack the skills to enable them to write coherently and with clarity.

This short course will teach the absolute essentials to enable you to start writing and express your personal story.



Creative Writing for Beginners/ Improvers - 10 wks. Fee €80

This 10 week Creative Writing course is for individuals starting out in the area of Creative Writing and who are seeking to learn the skills and nurture their creative ability.

Tuition will focus on teaching techniques of prose, poetry and dramatic story telling. There will be an emphasis on understanding of phrasing and sentence structure to convey images, build characters and develop plot.



Dressmaking

Altering and Upcycling your Wardrobe - 10 wks. Fee €170

We all have things in our wardrobe that do not fit or just do not suit anymore. This course shows you how to give your pre-loved garments a new lease of life and teaches you the essential skills to enable you to carry out simple alterations so that you can turn them into modern wearable pieces.

General Education

Mathematics for Parents and Adults - 8wks. Fee €70

This course is designed to help parents with their children's maths homework by covering topics that are included on the school curriculum. It will also demonstrate ways to bring maths to life at home, helping to make the subject relevant to everyday life. This course is also suitable for adults wanting to improve their maths.



Topics include the following;

Irish for Parents and Adults - 8 wks. Fee €70

This course is suitable for parents preparing their children to enrol in Gael-Scoileanna or similar immersive language settings. The focus will be on developing confidence and fluency in speaking and comprehension in the Irish language. Parents will learn how to communicate with their child's school in both oral and written formats. This course is also suitable for adults wanting to improve their command of the language.



Topics include the following;

- My body
- Weather
- My family
- Games/ Food/ Music
- Numbers
- Directions
- Festivals
- Simple spelling rules
- Address and compose a letter or email
- Meeting with the school teacher

Business and Technology

Search Engine Optimisation, SEO for Small Businesses - 5 wks. Fee €60

This short course is suitable for those in small businesses or individuals in startups wanting to maximize their web exposure and grow their business.

Whether you consider yourself, a 'techie' or not you will get an opportunity to learn how to optimize your company website or social media presence. You will learn the basic techniques required to understand how to increase website rankings and traffic. You will soon be seeing an improvement in your company or brand web presence.



Genealogy

Genealogy - 5 wks. Fee €40

Want to discover your ancestry and connect with past generations of your family. Find surviving relatives with whom they may have lost contact (or, indeed, never met) due to a variety of circumstances such as generational emigration or adoption.

Topics include the following;



- Instruction on how to perform a search of records; census, church, property and registry office records
- Accessing online research tools to compile genealogical records

Application Procedures

Enrolment:

Entry to all courses is by enrolment which requires the completion of an enrolment form and payment of the course fee. Unless otherwise stated enrolment on courses should be made in person at the college. Places on courses are allocated on the basis that the first to arrive is dealt with first. All courses must reach the quota to be deemed viable.

Application form and Interview/Briefing:

Completion of an application form and attendance at interview and or briefing is required prior to enrolling on a selected number of courses as follows;

- **QQI Level 6 National Tour Guiding** - Application form and Interview
- **QQI Level 5 & 6 Digital Marketing & Project Management** - Application form and Briefing
- **QQI Level 5 Maternity Care Support** - Application form and Briefing
- **QQI Level 5 Painting** - Briefing
- **Analogue Photographic Techniques** - Briefing

Application forms are available on the college website course page. Completed application forms must be submitted three weeks prior to the commencement of the course.

Fees:

Payment may be made by cheque, bank draft and postal order payable to the City of Dublin ETB, CDETB. Part payment is not accepted. VAT is not presently charged for Hobby and Self-Improvement course fees. However VAT at 23% may be introduced from January 2020.


